Dr. Dee Stern is a grief therapist, Chaplain at HSHS St. John's Hospital, facilitating three grief support groups including SOS (Survivors of Sucide---friends/families of those who have already ended their lives) and SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome).

Dee has recently published a book, "Comforting the Bereaved Through Listening and Positive Responding". What are the Bereaved Trying to Tell Us?---Archway Publishing.

Dee holds a Bachelor's Degree in Education, Master Degrees in Pastoral Studies and Psychology and a Doctorate in Psychology. Dee has taught Psychology and Death/Dying courses at Benedictine University, Springfield, for seven years and for a semester taught Social Psychology at Lincoln College in Lincoln, IL.

Dee is the Parish/Bereavement minister at the Church of the Little Flower in Springfield which includes visiting and taking the Eucharist to the homebound, sick and dying and assisting at Funeral Masses, Visitations and Burial Rites.

Are you bereaved? Do you know someone who is bereaved? Have you ever cried or felt lonely or lost after a death? When you go to a visitation or a funeral do you feel uncomfortable because you are not sure what to say to the family? Have your friends stopped calling you because your loved one died and they don't know what to say to you? These are just a few concerns addressed in Dr. Dee Stern's book as well as her presentation of "Women of the Bible".
