
Step 1: PREPARATION

■ Read aloud the chosen text.

DAY 1: Genesis 2:4b-10, 18, 21-25

• The Lord breathed into the man the breath of life.

DAY 2: Genesis 11:1-9

• It was called Babel because there the Lord confused the speech of all the world.

DAY 3: Exodus 19:3-8a, 16-20b

• The LORD came down upon Mount Sinai before all the people.

DAY 4: Proverbs 8:22-31

• I was beside him, like a master worker; rejoicing before him always.

DAY 5: Jeremiah 31:31-34

• I will make a new covenant, written on their hearts.

DAY 6: Ezekiel 37:1-14

• Dry bones of Israel, I will bring spirit into you, that you may come to life.

DAY 7: Joel 2:28-32 [RSV] Joel 3:1-5 [CEV, JB, NAB]

• I will pour out my spirit upon the servants and handmaids.

DAY 8: Romans 8:22-27

• The Spirit intercedes with inexpressible groanings.

DAY 9: John 7:37-39

• Rivers of living water will flow.

Step 4: REFLECTING ON GOD'S WORD

- Spend some time in silence.
- Talk with others about what struck you in the reading and in the silence.
- Write in your journal.



Step 5: CONCLUDING PRAYER

- v. Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful.
- R. And kindle in them the fire of your love.
- V. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created.
- R. And you shall renew the face of the earth.

In the same Spirit help us to relish what is right and always rejoice in your consolation.

- Nine days to prepare for the solemnity of Pentecost, the 50th day of Easter.
 - Nine days to pray that the Holy Spirit will work through our lives.
- Nine days that begin on the Friday of the Sixth Week of Easter and end on the Saturday before Pentecost Sunday, that last day of the Easter Season:

06-14 May 2016 25 May-03 June 2017 11-19 May 2018 30-May-08 June 2019 22-30 May 2020 14-22 May 2021
